Dear Parents/Carers,

The nursery children will now begin to do a variety of Christmas activities and preparing for their recorded Christmas performances.



Last Friday, your child brought home in their yellow bag ...

The letter sounds are 'N n' and 'H h'. Please continue to match objects to numerals 1-5 and identify 2D shapes.



Please let your Key-worker know if you feel your child has confidently learnt their pencil words.

Reminder: The nursery is continuing to operate the staggered times for children to enter the building to prevent queuing for any length of time.
